

Greetings Brothers and Sisters,

Please receive a huge hug from us here at Voice of The Light Ministries. We cannot express in words what your support and faithfulness mean to each of us, and rest assured our goal each day is to deliver exactly what we see and hear the Father doing and saying.

Today I would like to share what He is revealing to me at this time, and I pray it will be useful to you in the coming days and months.

Our fascination with “time” and our “physical safety” consumes the majority of our awareness on a daily basis. This consumption of energy depletes God’s design for our daily needs to be met supernaturally. What does that mean?

In Matthew 6, Jesus taught His disciples to ask for their needs today. Why do we have the right to demand our needs be met? Look at this!

Give us today the food we need, and forgive us our sins, as we have forgiven those who sin against us.

Matthew 6:11-12 NLT

Jesus is saying, “*When you are conscious of the relationship with your fellow man you will lose your fascination with yourself and safety.*” This detachment from our preoccupation with ourselves releases Divine intervention to supply solutions for our daily needs.

In other words, if we are the first to forgive those who may have done us wrong or injured us, we are in a *state of forgiveness*. That mentality positions us for *supernatural synchronicities*, which are the *unforeseen blessings* that surprise us and remind us that our Heavenly Father is right there by our side.

You may say, “*I know all about forgiveness and I do forgive others, but I am still struggling with my finances and needs.*” Beloved, that forgiveness is not limited to others but to us as well.

Unfortunately, most of us have grown up in churches that interpret the scriptures from the *shadow of the Law*. Remember, the Law was the shadow of Christ, but it was NOT the resurrected Christ. His resurrection took away all the condemnation we have heard subtly mixed into many sermons and interpretations inside the churches.

Why do I say that? Most of the churches I attended judged me according to the commandments of Moses because that was their idea of holy. It didn't matter that Jesus said, "*Judge not...*" because we all did it anyway. All this to say, if we have experienced condemnation in any form, it subtly has an effect on us and can lead to the *unforgiveness of ourselves*.

Begin this next year by *forgiving yourselves* and asking the Holy Spirit to reveal to you the places inside your heart where condemnation resides. This will change your mentality and physical condition because you will be asking God for your daily needs as His Son, and not as a sinner who is waiting for the crumbs or leftovers. Trust me, your life will never be the same.

Before I close, I hear the Holy Spirit telling me to share something with those who have ears to hear.

Time is relative in this dimension because material objects (*which includes our identities as physical beings*) are confined by gravity. Nevertheless, God is increasing the speed of objects inside this dimension, which will force us to adapt to a different perception of our environment.

In other words, our preoccupation with predicting the future from our past experiences to protect ourselves from unforeseen danger will force us to either *live in the present moment (which is faith)* or *live in fear (which is the foundation of this world)*.

The increased speed will be like adding more heat to boiling water and will expose the fearful from the faithful. It will also allow God to remove you from circumstances and events that may have hindered you in the past. This will reveal greater and greater opportunity for those who *remain in the moment with God and have no attraction to this world system.*

Therefore, in the coming months ***those who practice the presence of God will be showered with “revelations for solutions” for the frightened masses running “here and there” for help.*** These people will be receptive to the love and mercies of God and will provide God with persons for the future generations.

We must never forget that God purchased this world through the sacrifice of His Son and will never forsake mankind.

Our physical time here will come to an end but our legacy as His Son will live on for eternity. These coming months will offer us outstanding opportunities in that pursuit.

We expect you to be blessed and filled with His Spirit and thank you for your love and support throughout this year and for the next year to come.

I want to encourage you to give not because we depend on your money, but we know that *giving is the first step in breaking our dependence on this world’s system for our security and safety.*
